## **Happy New School Year from LCS**

We are thrilled to share the 2023-24 projects and programs you have made possible! 47 students and 12 staff members started this year's journey - more participants than ever before. We are offering eight new project-based courses, including Global Memoirs, World Religions, and Chemistry. Our building has newly tiled floors and freshly painted murals as well as extra student-centered learning spaces such as a Math Resource Center, Arts & Crafts Studio, and Science Lab. The expansion of our alternative education program, made possible by a renovation in our upstairs space, is underway. We aim to open our program to 60 students next year! -Extracurriculars: Positive school culture, student recognition, and vocational experiences will be highlighted during this daily community time.


